

## REGULATIONS

The Championships are played between players, members of the Dolomiti club, who have registered by Sunday 21 May. Play is according to the Rules of the Royal & Ancient Rules Limited and according to the Local Rules of Golf Dolomiti valid on the day of the match.

Matches must be played over 18 holes with Match Play formula:

- **Scratch** for players with playing Hcp 14 or lower (with the possibility of up to Hcp 24);
- **Pareggiato** for players with Hcp 15 or higher;
- **Pareggiato Ladies** with Hcp Index of any value;
- **Pareggiato Seniores** with Hcp Index of any value.

At the end of the pairings, the HCP INDEX recorded in the FIG archive on the closing date of entries applies.

Once the scoreboards with the various pairings have been drawn up, the matches can preferably start on the dates indicated or at least the same are considered as deadlines within which to play them.

The games of the matches must be pre-announced to the secretariat and preferably played on the dates listed above.

**For the purposes of the advantage for the Pareggiati Championships, the entire HCP difference of the two opponents counts. The player with the lowest Hcp grants the player with the highest Hcp the full difference in game hcp.**

The starting point of each tee is indicated by the fixed distance point (plates). Competitors pitch the hole to within two sticks (also forward) of the following markers. Yellow departures for males and red for females, with the possibility for those entitled to use the advanced tees.

The pairings are carried out according to the guideline of the FIG 23' Technical Regulations.

If one of the matches is not played for any reason or if a player does not show up at the starting tee of hole 1 on the expiry date of the pre-established slot and by 3.00 pm, the player present will pass his turn. In case of absence of both interested parties, they will be disqualified.

In the event of a tie after 18 holes played, the game continues on hole 1 until one of the competitors takes the lead by one hole.

The committee reserves the right to make all the changes necessary to the present regulation for the best performance of the Championships.



# ECLECTIC of the PRESIDENT and GOLDEN SCORE '23

## REGULATIONS

The **PRESIDENT'S ECLECTIC** is played between players, members of the GC Dolomiti club, who have registered by Sunday 21 May. It is played according to the Rules of the Royal & Ancient Rules Limited and according to the Local Rules of Golf Dolomiti valid on the day of competition.

**The scoring system takes into account the sum of the netto results obtained on each day of competition in the three categories of play as follows: 0-14, 15-24, 25-54.**

The "**SCORE D'ORO - LIVIO COVI**" ranking will automatically include all members without any contribution. It will take into account the best scores achieved hole by hole and will be updated automatically after the next tournament has been played.

**Tournaments marked on the calendar, posted in the secretary's office, with the symbol  $\otimes$  are valid for the classification of the PRESIDENT'S ECLECTIC and for the "SCORE D'ORO - LIVIO COVI".** All individual tournament on the calendar will be taken into account (excluding Bristol Buja Challenge tournament and tournament reserved for special cat. such as Juniores, Ladies, etc.).

In both classifications, updating one's HCP will involve moving from one category to another.

The Sports Commission reserves the right to make any changes to the programme, HCP categories and game formulas. Therefore, please consult the notice board at the secretariat.
